



OILSEAL

DESCRIPTION

OILSEAL is a modified hydrocarbon of a selected particle size designed to offer optimum control of loss circulation in oil-base and invert fluids used in drilling, workover/completion and other applications. OILSEAL is a black/dark brown granular material. OILSEAL is soluble in most hydrocarbons and therefore can be removed and is essentially non-damaging if exposed to oil over a length of time.

APPLICATION

OILSEAL provides an economic means of controlling loss circulation in any oil-base or invert drilling system.

RECOMMENDED TREATMENT

The recommended treatment depends upon severity of the loss of circulation. Pills of OILSEAL can be prepared and placed in the zone of the loss circulation for maximum effectiveness.

PACKAGING

OILSEAL is packaged in 50 lb net export bags.
